Value Chain: Attendees' notes



- > I consider testing department broader than my testing team department.
- > Testing activities are under development and business responsibilities too.
- Do improvement in the way it will be beneficial to all test phases.
- In one action, you always think about the complete quality chain.
- Work toward having development executives as allies or sponsors to push and support your initiatives
- Every support activities must be addressed in order to get "margin" to your main activities.
- > The barriers between QA department and others need to fall to have better ROI

Quality principles

Agile principles:

Quality at every step Acceptance criterias (quality embedded) User stories as test cases (BDD, TDD) Automation is key to short cycles



DevOps and Continuous testing principles:

Test early (& fail early)

Test often (& fail often)

Test fast (Automate as much as possible (and efficient))

Quality Principles: Attendees' notes



- All those new methodologies and concept put emphasis on Quality.
- > Surf onto those principles to push improvement on quality activities along the delivery cycle.
- > Put emphasis on every single element that should have quality activity apply to.
- > Get out of test methodology and jump into software development life cycle.
- Show references to uphold your recommendations.
- You, as a QA leader, should always be around the table from the start (Enterprise transformation, IT methodologies workshops, and so on).
- Don't miss your chance to be the leader your organization needs!

What is a Quality chain?

Software Development Life Cycle:

- Everyone has a role to play to deliver the solution
- Everyone has a role to play to deliver QUALITY into the solution

Testing team should not be the only group concerned about Quality Where are the weakest links?

From a testing team to an organization quality chain



Quality Chain: Attendees' notes



- > I see it like a chain of quality and testing activities
- > If you skip one, it will be expensive in time and effort to try to overcome that weak link
- ➤ Weak links? The vocabulary, the roles, the test phases, etc.
- ➤ I always worked with the development teams to make them understand that a weak link cannot be compensated by a stronger one.
- ➤ Come to them with solutions, with your test department expertise to train them, coach them to do better testing, recommend some testing tools.
- > The quality department need to work on all links of the quality chain
- > Executives react on the FIRST answer. carefully choose the one you want to answer first!
